WHAT IS THE LIVE PROJECT IN OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT ABOUT?

- It is a **real consulting project** that a team of six SSE students runs for **you**, **the client**.
- From the end of October to mid December, the SSE team analyzes and proposes solutions to an operations related challenge that you have assigned them. Their work is supported by expert coaches who are part of SSE faculty.
- The deliverables of the Live Project include an in-depth analysis of the problem and improvement suggestions, both in written and oral forms.



THE LIVE PROJECT IS THE KEY BUILDING BLOCK OF 612 COURSE IN OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT

- The course runs in the 3rd year of SSE Bachelor of Science in Business and Economics.
- The pedagogical philosophy of the course is experiential learning. The Live Project is the fundamental tool to achieve such learning as it gives students the opportunity to test their knowledge in a real concrete context and to gain hands-on experience of operations and process management.
- Your participation is therefore very valuable for both parties: you get extensive work and commitment from students, students get knowledge and experience from you.



WHAT BUSINESS CHALLENGES ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE ADDRESSED IN THE LIVE PROJECT?

- The type of problems that can be object of the Live Project can vary within a wide spectrum.
- That's because the course is deliberately broad. We intend
 operations management as designing, running and improving
 business processes. That's what we train students to do.
- The course is not focused on the production function of a manufacturing firm. Instead, it surfs across functions, from marketing and finance to HR and R&D, and sectors, including service, not for profit and public administrations.
- Processes exist in all functions, at any levels! All managers should be concerned with having efficient and effective processes.

Confirm participation

- Inform us that you want to organize one or more Live Projects
- When? As soon as possible

Prepare project briet

- Prepare a brief description of the problem and the context of the Live Project. Use the LPB template enclosed.
- When? By September, 11th, 2015

Select the team

- One or more teams of students will prepare a project proposal on the basis of your brief. If more than one, select who you want to work with!
- When? In mid-late September, 2015

The Live Project is on!

- Six students will work on your Live Project. A total of 3 person-months will be dedicated to solving your challenge.
- When? From the end of October to late December 2015.

SO, WHAT DO WE NEED FROM YOU?

- A confirmation of your participation to one or more Live Projects and the name of a person who can serve as primary contact (at your earliest convenience).
- The Live Project Brief, according to the LPB template enclosed (By September 11th, 2015).
- Selection of the team of consultants for your Live Project (if applicable, after screening the project proposals) (In mid-late September, 2015).
- Interaction, information and feedback to the students. You decide how, how much, when, where!
