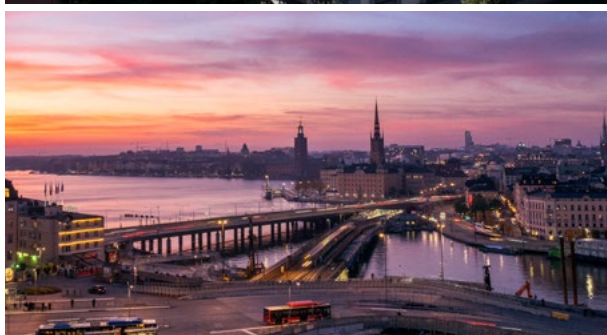

PRACTICALITIES

The setting offers beautiful nature, lakeside views, and a taste of the Swedish summer at its best.

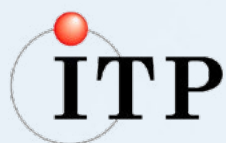
